## Air Quality Flag Etiquette

To properly fly your air quality flag, follow these basic rules:

- When multiple flags are flown on the same pole, fly the U.S. flag above all other flags or pennants (e.g., air quality flag, corporate or organization flag, etc.).
- When there are two or more adjacent flag poles, hoist the U.S. flag first and lower it last.
- When the U.S. flag is at half mast, it should be at the mid-point of the pole. Fly all other flags and pennants below it.
